The program starts annually in April and consists of four semesters. Classes are held bi-weekly on Fridays (1pm to 8pm) and Saturdays (9am to 5pm) during semesters 1 through 3 plus 14 weeks for the master thesis in semester 4.

Tuition covers university semester fees for four semesters including the RMV semester ticket. Upon accepting an offer of admission, applicants are asked to remit a non-refundable tuition deposit of EUR 1,000.

#### INSTALLMENTS

The tuition (less the non-refundable tuition deposit) is payable in three installments:

#### SCHOLARSHIPS



Students wishing to enroll in the Risk Management specialization may apply for a scholarship provided by the Frankfurt Institute for Risk Management and Regulation (FIRM).

#### REQUIREMENTS

As a minimum requirement for admissions, we expect you to have:

- first university degree (bachelor 180 CP or equivalent)
- advanced English skills
- minimum of one year of post-degree professional finance-related work experience

#### APPLICATION

To apply, you must submit a complete application package to the Office of Admissions:

- completed program application form
- current resume
- recommendation form
- confirmation of post-graduate professional work experience
- essay of motivation
- proof of English proficiency at the C1 CEFR level (e.g. IELTS or TOEFL-iBT)
- official university transcripts and diploma (only originals or notarized/„beglaubigt“ copies are accepted)
